Hollis Area Equestrians Show Rules

Warm up 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM plus short warm up before each Division Starting with Green Horse

- 1. SEI/ASTM approved hard hats required when mounted.
- 2. Shoes with heels required (NO SNEAKERS).
- 3. Saddles required in all riding classes.
- 4. Show attire is NOT required.
- 5. Judge & Show Management decisions are final.
- 6. Classes/Divisions may be combined/divided or cancelled at judge or show committee discretion.
- 7. All ages are as of 1/1/2024.
- 8. No alcohol permitted on the grounds.
- 9. No Refunds. Adding classes day of Show \$20.00.
- 10. Current Negative Coggins required.
- 11. No Schooling allowed in the parking lot. (Warm up 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM plus short warm up before each Division Starting with Green Horse)
- 12. Bitless bridles and bosals are allowed. Any bit or Bridle that is extreme and can cause pain to a horse's mouth is not allowed.
- 13. Riders may perform one or two-handed regardless of bit/bridle type. Riders must remain that way thru the entire class. Example a rider cannot enter the ring one-handed and then switch to two-handed during their class.
- 14. Lead Line and Walk Trot riders may not enter flat classes that require cantering.
- 15. Points are counted with same horse/rider combination.

Class Descriptions

Dressage Suitability is a class for Western and English Dressage Riders.

Equitation is a class where the rider is evaluated on their position while mounted and encompasses a rider's ability to ride correctly and with effective aids.

Pleasure is a class where the horse is evaluated on how pleasurable they are to ride. Horses are judged on their manners, performance, smoothness and consistency.

Disciplined Rail is a class, which tests the skills of both horse and rider, as they execute specific gaits, transitions and movements as requested by the judge.

Natural Horsemanship is a class, which shows the relationship you have with your horse to the Judge by demonstrating class requirements without physically touching your horse. Use your body movements to signal your horse. For safety reasons we would like you to hold onto your horse on a loose lead with one hand only while dropping your other hand to your side. Please use both hands in the event your horse becomes unruly or becomes out of control and is at risk of getting away from you.

Showmanship is a class where cleanliness of the horse is not judged.
